# Nebraska Quarter Horse Association Hall of Fame Nomination

The Nebraska Quarter Horse Hall of Fame's purpose is to acknowledge the impact of any horse or human upon the American Quarter Horse industry. NQHA members are encouraged to submit a nomination packet for horses or humans whose activities and/or achievements have impacted the American Quarter Horse industry, whether in Nebraska or nationwide.

# CRITERIA

All candidates for induction must be nominated under the following guidelines and sorted into one of two categories:

#### **HORSE**

May or may not be deceased and must be recognized in the AQHA breed registry.

Horse must be outstanding for a multitude of years as a sire, dam, competitor OR brought visibility to the American Quarter Horse breed.

# **HUMAN**

May or may not be deceased, and has or had conducted themselves in a positive way that is becoming of the honor of a Hall of Fame induction.

Person is or was a member in good standing with the Nebraska Quarter Horse Association and/or made significant impact on NQHA and the Quarter Horse industry.

Person whose activities occurred during the existence of NQHA (post 1950), and should be outstanding over a multitude of years and contributed to the advancement of NQHA.

# **HOW TO NOMINATE**

**COVER LETTER**-Nominator must submit a

cover letter.

NOMINEE SUMMARY—Nominator must complete a summary form which summarizes the nominee's industry-related activities, offices held, honor, achievements, (horse) prominent offspring, other industry activities and achievements.

LETTERS OF SUPPORT—Nominator must include a minimum of two reference letters. Letters should be at least one page in length. These letters must be prepared by an individual with direct knowledge of the nominee's activities, accomplishments or impact within the NQHA. For the horse category this can be the owner or breeder of the horse, exhibitor, trainer, etc. For the Human category it can be a family member, personal or close family friend, a business associate, etc.

Nominator may include supplementary materials to enhance the nominee's application (press releases, newspaper articles, stories, etc.). The nominator must provide substantiating documentation for verification of all achievements. (Maximum five pages.)

A bibliography page may be included in the packet which lists in chronological order the dates of the achievements.

# **EVALUATION PROCEDURE**

All Nebraska Quarter Horse Association Hall of Fame nominations will be evaluated by the Hall of Fame committee (currently Lori Bucholz and Debby Brehm).
